

Governance & Electoral Roll

Our church is governed by St John's and St Paul's Parochial Church Council (PCC), who are elected representatives of the Church Electoral Roll.

The electoral roll is a way of saying 'I belong' – an act of commitment to the local church and to the church as a whole. It also enables you to vote at the church's annual meeting (the APCM). To be on the church electoral roll you need to have worshipped and/or belonged to one of our Connect Groups at Transform Widnes regularly for at least the last six months or be a resident in the parish.
